Curriculum over view:

English	This week we will focus on personal writing in the form of diaries. This is linked to the Great Fire of London.
Maths	This will be a review week where we will consolidate learning on Place value. This will include reasoning and problem solving.
Science	This half term we will focus on the theme Animals including Humans. This week we will be sense detectives and perform a test to investigate the five senses.
Topic	This term our topic is The Great Fire of London and this week the children will construct a model/ plan of a building, depicting and discussing their ideas.
Music	The children will listen with concentration and understanding to a high-quality recording and experiment with pitch; combining sounds from un-tuned instruments.
RE	Our theme this half term is Creation and we will explore the question - who created the world?
PSHE	Our theme this half term is Me and My School. This week we will learn about how a school council meeting works.
Computing	The children will match images and audio data types using a simple drag and drop activity.
PE	During the autumn term the children will be doing multi-skills on a Tuesday and dance on a Thursday with our sports coaches.
