Curriculum over view:

English	We will continue to focus on mini-beast non-fiction text.
Maths	We will focus on addition and subtraction word problems.
Science	We will continue with our topic on Plants. This week the children will be observing their beans and recording any changes. They will also be observing changes made to plants kept in different conditions. We will be planting some cress.
ICT	The children will create a list of websites and learn how to stay safe by accurately entering the website address. They will also understand what to do if they visit a website they don't recognise.
Topic	Our theme this term is What a Wonderful World. The children will learn about hot and cold countries around the world. The children will also be sharing their travel brochures and globes with each other and the class.
RE	This term our theme is Exploring Worship. The children will learn how and when faith communities meet together for worship and why this is important. They will also discuss why it's important for them to meet together with others.
PSHE	This term our theme is Me in the World. This week we will look at some animals and the children will be discussing likes/dislikes and if it would be right or wrong to keep each of the animals as pets and why.
PE	This term we will have Multi-skills on Tuesdays and Games/Athletics on Thursdays.

Resources children need to remember to bring from home this week:

Monday	Spelling logs should be returned.
Tuesday & Thursday	Is PE day so hair should be tied back and PE kit in school. Jewellery should not be worn for PE sessions.
