Curriculum over view:

English	This week the children will discuss and write about what they have enjoyed learning about this term
Maths	Y1: Will focus on addition within 10. Y2: Will focus on addition methods which will include the part whole model, number lines and column method.
Science	This half term we will focus on the theme Animals including Humans. The children will record what information they found out during the senses investigation. We will talk about healthy foods and the children will sample foods and design a healthy lunchbox. We will also plant daffodil bulbs.
Topic	This term our topic is The Great Fire of London and this week we will have a visit by the Fire Brigade to discuss fire safety and how fire fighting has changed since 1666.
