Home Learning

Homework each week includes approximately five minutes a day learning their number facts and learning the spellings. The multiplication and division facts test will take place on Thursday s and spellings on Fridays each week unless told otherwise.

Children have been issued with an English speech punctuation task and a Maths task. It is vital that these be returned next *Monday 25th September*, please, as we look at the home learning in class and work on any misconceptions together.
