Home Learning

There is no written Home Learning this week because of the Half Term holidays. However, we would like those children who are not secure in all of the basic number facts to continue with last week's task which is copied here:

We would like the children to focus on mathematical fluency which involves a good recall of basic addition and subtraction facts. We have sent home another copy of these which were included in the Class 3 welcome packs. It is vital that children know all of these facts as they are then enabled to add and subtract larger numbers and to multiply and divide. Please try to learn two or three of these each night & talk about how they relate to larger numbers.

For example:

$3+4= 7$ helps us with: $30+40= 70$

$300+400= 700$

$13+14= 27$.
