Ask them why they have chosen the groups that they have, and encourage them to use mathematical vocabulary. Y3 can be expected to use the words longer, shorter, right angle, symmetrical, same, greater than, less than. Y4 should also be using the terms obtuse, acute, equilateral, scalene, isosceles. Could they be sorted again but according to different criteria?
