What are we doing in Class One this week?

- This week we will continue our learning about 'toys that move' as well as the Stick Man story.
- Craft club continues this Wednesday. Pick up is 4pm prompt from the main school entrance. Thank you.
- Bike-ability - This Thursday is the first session of balance bike skills for Reception and Year 1 children. Please can we remind you that all children will need trainers, jogging bottoms and a sensible coat for each session.
- Reception - 'Fundercats' after school club continues this Tuesday for Reception and Year 1. If your child is attending this club please can they have PE kit in School ready.
- Walk to School - As you may already know we are trying to encourage the children to walk/cycle/scoot or park and stride to school as often as they can as part of a walk to school project. We have arranged for you to park at Oulton Abbey and the Village Hall to enable Park and Stride walkers. We really appreciate the constraints of time on you, but hope you can support us in encouraging your children to be more active, to cut down on parking problems and promote healthy choices.
