What are we doing in Class One this week?

- This week we will be having a block week of RE learning. We will also be consolidating what we have learnt in addition and subtraction using money.
- Bike-ability - The children really enjoyed their balance bike sessions last Thursday. This continues this Thursday. Please can we remind you that all children will need trainers, jogging bottoms and a sensible coat for each session.
- Reception - 'Fundercats' after school club continues this Tuesday for Reception and Year 1. If your child is attending this club please can they have PE kit in School ready.
