Curriculum over view:

English	This week the children will write a recount about their visit to St. John's Church and write instructions for hand washing.
Maths	Y1: Will complete the unit on addition and subtraction within 20 Y2: Will complete the unit on multiplication and division of 2, 5 & 10.
Science	We will begin a new theme after half term.
Topic	This term our topic is people who have been famous for more than 5 minutes. This half term we will focus on nurturing nurses and next half term on artists. This week we will focus on how hospitals and nursing has changed since the Crimea War.
Music	The children will focus on the season's theme and identify changes in pitch and respond to them with movement. They will contrast changes in pitch with changes in dynamics (volume).
RE	Our theme this half term is Worship and Ceremonies. This week we will visit St. John's Church to observe different images and areas of worship.
PSHE	Our theme this half term is Happy and Healthy Me. The children will learn about personal hygiene, healthy eating and exercise. Following on from the NSPCC assembly we will be discussing the NSPCC's Underwear Rule. Computing	The children will focus on keyboard skills.
PE	During the Spring term the children will be doing boxercise on a Tuesday and games on a Thursday with our sports coaches.
