**Curriculum over view:**

<b>English</b>	We will continue to focus on the book <i>The Journey Home</i> which links to science and topic. This week pupils will be retelling the story in their own words and writing a persuasive letter about why it is important to save these animals.
<b>Maths</b>	Y1: Will focus on multiplication. Y2: Will be revising maths learning to date.
<b>Science</b>	This half term our theme is <i>Wild and Wonderful Creatures</i> . This week pupils will be creating a wild animal habitat.
<b>Topic</b>	This term our topic is <i>Sensational Safari</i> . This week pupils will understand what life is like for people in Kenya by contrasting a small area of the UK with a small area there. They will also understand what a national park is in the context of Africa.
<b>Music</b>	The children will create a picture in sound using percussion instruments.
<b>RE</b>	Our theme this half term is <i>What do Christians believe God is like?</i> We will focus on the parable <i>The Lost Son</i> and pupils will consider what the story means to Christians.
<b>PSHE</b>	Our theme this half term is <i>Me and Other People</i> . Children will learn to understand and respect the differences between boys and girls, the range of families and racial diversity in British society today.
<b>Computing</b>	
<b>PE</b>	During the Summer term the children will be doing multi-skills on a Tuesday and athletics on a Thursday with our sports coaches.
