Curriculum over view:

English	For the next two weeks we will focus on Traditional Tales, specifically the Three Little Pigs which children will learn to retell off by heart.
Maths	Y1: Will focus on addition and subtraction within 20 Y2: Will focus on multiplication and division of 2, 5 & 10.
Science	This week we will complete our focus on the weather and discuss the weather diaries that we kept last week. We will also learn how animals and humans adapt to the winter weather. We will also begin our new theme - Brilliant Builders which will focus on everyday materials. This week we will explore and group materials.
Topic	This term our topic is people who have been famous for more than 5 minutes. This half term we will focus on nurturing nurses and next half term on artists.
Music	The children will focus on the season's theme and identify changes in pitch and respond to them with movement. They will contrast changes in pitch with changes in dynamics (volume).
RE	Our theme this half term is Worship and Ceremonies. This week we will consider how faith communities use actions, gestures and rituals as part of worship and ceremonies.
PSHE	Our theme this half term is Happy and Healthy Me.
Computing	This term we will focus on internet safety by learning how to keep safe online
PE	During the Spring term the children will be doing boxercise on a Tuesday and games on a Thursday with our sports coaches.
