Curriculum over view:

English	This week pupils will complete their alternative version story of the Three Little Pigs. For the next few weeks we will focus on the alternative traditional tale Jim and the Beanstalk.
Maths	Y1: Will focus on numbers to 40. Y2: Will focus on money.
Science	This half term our theme is Plants - Growing things. This week pupils will look at a variety of different potatoes and plant the seed potatoes that we chitted last week.
Topic	This term our topic is people who have been famous for more than 5 minutes. This half term we will focus on famous artists.
Music	The children will focus on learning the songs for Mother's Day.
RE	Our theme this half term is Belonging to a Group. This week we will focus on groups that each pupil belongs to. For example, family, faith, Rainbows, Cubs or a sporting activity, etc. Children will need to bring something to school on TUESDAY that shows they belong to a group, e.g. badge, certificate, photo or item of clothing. These will be used for display.
PSHE	Our theme this half term is Me and My Relationships.
Computing	The children will learn what a flowchart is and understand how it can be followed. To debug their own and others' flowcharts.
PE	During the Spring term the children will be doing athletics on a Tuesday and games on a Thursday with our sports coaches.
