Curriculum over view:

English	This week we will focus on researching and writing a biography on Florence Nightingale. This is linked to our topic of significant people.
Maths	Y1: Will complete the unit on positions and begin a unit on numbers to 20. Y2: Will focus on multiplication of 2, 5 and 10.
Science	This half term we will continue to focus on the weather. We will discuss weather symbols and observe the weather throughout the day.
Topic	This term our topic is people who have been famous for more than 5 minutes. This half term we will focus on nurturing nurses and next half term on artists. This week pupils will learn about the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements and use a Time Line.
Music	The children will learn understand how music can tell a story. Pupils will perform with concentration.
RE	Our theme this half term is Worship and Ceremonies. This week we will consider how people use actions, gestures and rituals in their everyday lives with a specific focus on our school assembly.
PSHE	Our theme this half term is Happy and Healthy Me. This week pupils will be naming body parts.
