Curriculum over view:

English	This week we will use the research on Florence Nightingale to complete a biography. This is linked to our topic of significant people. We will also be learning about formal and informal letters.
Maths	Y1: We will focus on numbers to 20. Y2: Will focus on multiplication of 2, 5 and 10.
Science	This half term we will continue to focus on the weather. Pupils will create a 'seasons' collage.
Topic	This term our topic is people who have been famous for more than 5 minutes. This half term we will focus on nurturing nurses and next half term on artists. This week pupils will focus on Mary Seacole.
Music	The children will create music that matches an event in a story, playing it fast, slow, loud and quiet.
