Curriculum over view:

English	For the next three weeks we will focus on the book <i>The Journey Home</i> which links to science and topic. This week pupils will be creating a poster, writing a letter and creating an animal fact file.
Maths	Y1: Will focus on length and height. Y2: Will focus on statistics and fractions.
Science	This half term our theme is <i>Wild and Wonderful Creatures</i> . This week pupils will identify and discuss the characteristics of different animals and categorise them according to their features.
Topic	This term our topic is <i>Sensational Safari</i> . This week pupils will name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans in the context of Africa (Kenya) by using maps, atlases and globes.
Music	The children will combine voices, movement and instruments to perform a chant and a song.
RE	Our theme this half term is <i>What do Christians believe God is like?</i> We will focus on the parable <i>The Lost Son</i> .
PSHE	Our theme this half term is <i>Me and Other People</i> . Children will learn to understand and respect the differences between boys and girls, the range of families and racial diversity in British society today.
Computing	The children will use technology purposefully to create, organise and manipulate digital content. They will sequence a series of events into the correct order.
PE	During the Summer term the children will be doing multi-skills on a Tuesday and athletics on a Thursday with our sports coaches.
