Curriculum over view:

English	For the next two weeks we will focus on list poems. Pupils will read, discuss and perform poems and finally write their own seasonal list poem.
Maths	Y1: Will focus on addition and subtraction within 20 Y2: Will complete multiplication of 2, 5 & 10 and then begin a unit on multiplication and division of 2, 5 & 10.
Science	This half term we will continue to focus on the weather. This week pupils will make a weather station including a rain gauge and wind sock.
Topic	This term our topic is people who have been famous for more than 5 minutes. This half term we will focus on nurturing nurses and next half term on artists. This week pupils will focus on Mary Seacole and Edith Cavell.
Music	The children will create music that matches an event in a story, playing it fast, slow, loud and quiet.
RE	Our theme this half term is Worship and Ceremonies. This week we will consider how people use actions, gestures and rituals in their everyday lives with a specific focus on our school assembly.
PSHE	Our theme this half term is Happy and Healthy Me. This week pupils will be naming body parts.
Computing	The children will become more confident using a mouse when completing simple tasks
PE	During the Spring term the children will be doing boxercise on a Tuesday and games on a Thursday with our sports coaches.
