### Curriculum over view:

<b>English</b>	We will continue with list poems this week. Pupils will read, discuss and perform poems and finally write their own seasonal list poem.
<b>Maths</b>	Y1: Will focus on addition and subtraction within 20 Y2: Will focus on multiplication and division of 2, 5 & 10.
<b>Science</b>	This half term we will continue to focus on the weather. This week we will put our weather station into action and use a weather diary to record the weather.
<b>Topic</b>	This term our topic is people who have been famous for more than 5 minutes. This half term we will focus on nurturing nurses and next half term on artists. This week pupils will compare the role of nurses in different periods, understand historical concepts such as change and describe qualities needed to be a nurse.
<b>Music</b>	The children will focus on the season's theme and identify changes in pitch and respond to them with movement. They will contrast changes in pitch with changes in dynamics (volume).
<b>RE</b>	Our theme this half term is Worship and Ceremonies. This week we will consider how people use actions, gestures and rituals in their everyday lives with a specific focus on our school assembly.
<b>PSHE</b>	Our theme this half term is Happy and Healthy Me. This week pupils will be naming body parts.
<b>Computing</b>	The children will become more confident using a keyboard by typing simple words and sentences containing numbers, letters and symbols.
<b>PE</b>	During the Spring term the children will be doing boxercise on a Tuesday and games on a Thursday with our sports coaches.
