Personal, Social & Emotional Development	Our topic this half term is 'Me and My Safety.' We will be drawing a picture for Bonfire night and talking about how we stay safe around fireworks.
*Communication & Language *Literacy	This week we will be focusing on Remembrance day and why the 11 th November is important. We will be writing labels for our medal and writing instructions on how we made poppies.
*Maths	This week Reception and Ladybirds will be learning about Seal Six (6) we will be looking at how to write it, how to count it, what it looks like on a tens frame, how to make 6 in different ways using our part whole model.
* Understanding the World	Our topic this term is light and dark. This week we will be learning the difference between day and night and what happens to the sun. We will also look at what we do during the day and at night time.
*Physical Development	This half term Reception and Nursery will be learning dance in their PE sessions with Miss Amy. Ladybirds will also be learning their dance routine for our Nativity performance.

*Expressive Arts & Design	This week the children will be creating firework pictures using paint and they will be mixing their own colours.
*Religious Education	This week in RE the children will be learning that everybody starts their life off as a baby and that Jesus did the same. We will look at the important people in the story of the Nativity.
