#### What are we doing in Class One this week?

- We have now completed our baseline assessments and we are ready to begin our learning. Below is a table where you can see what we will be learning each week.
- Phonics learning will be going home every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Ten Town will be going home on a Friday. The children's home learning isn't expected to take more than 10 minutes but it gives you an indication what they have learnt that day and the rhyme for formation. Alongside their home learning we still encourage children to read every day whether that is their phonic book or a story from home.
- Parent's phonics meeting 6-7pm is this Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> September. We hope to see you all there.
- Below are some notifications to make you aware of as some of you are new to our school.
  - From our PE session we are encouraging children to be as independent as possible. Could we ask that when your child is at home they try to take their own clothes off and try to get them on. We would like them to practice putting on T-shirts as well as taking them off, putting on their own socks and in time doing their little buttons. We will encourage them as much as possible to have a try before we help.
  - If you child has sickness or Diarrhoea then they are required to be off school for 48hours after the last motion.
  - Those of you that haven't brought wellies in for your child, could we ask that they are brought in soon as possible as children without wellies will be unable to go outside if it is wet.
