Curriculum over view:

English	We will continue to focus on the author John Burningham. This week we will use the text <i>The Magic Bed</i> and pupils will create their own fantasy story.
Maths	Y1: Subtraction within 10. Y2: Subtraction within 100.
Science	This half term our theme is <i>Seasonal Changes</i> and this week pupils will explore the school grounds to observe the living environment and how it changes over the four seasons.
Topic	This term our topic is <i>Our Country and the Local Area</i> . This week pupils will recognise human & physical features in the context of their own locality and complete a follow up task related to our village walk.
Music	This term pupils will focus on learning the songs for our <i>Christmas play</i> .
RE	Our theme this half term is <i>Incarnation</i> and pupils will consider the question - <i>Why is Christmas important to Christians?</i>
Computing	Children will learn practise logging on/ off and saving tasks to their new computer files.
PSHE	Our theme this half term is <i>Me and My Safety</i> . This week is <i>anti-bullying week</i> so we will focus on the theme <i>Respect</i> .
PE	During the autumn term the children will be doing <i>boxercise</i> on a Tuesday and <i>dance</i> on a Thursday.
