Curriculum over view:

English	For the next two weeks we will focus on Information texts. This is linked to our science focus on pets. Pupils will research and create a fact file about pets.
Maths	Y1: Addition/subtraction within 10. Y2: Addition and subtraction.
Science	This half term our theme is People and their Pets (Animals Inc Humans). This week pupils will be visited by a puppy and find out how to keep the puppy happy and healthy.
Topic	This term our topic is Our Country and the Local Area. This week pupils will be identifying key features of the countries of the UK. This is linked to the computer for research.
Music	This week pupils will be recognising and responding to a steady beat and a rhythm ostinato pattern. They will also recognise and play rhythmic patterns.
RE	Our theme this half term is Families.
Computing	Pupils will use the computer to research topic and English.
PSHE	Our theme this half term is Me and My School. This week the children will write about a time when they have experienced a negative feeling and how they dealt with it.
PE	During the autumn term the children will be doing multi-skills on a Tuesday and dance on a Thursday.
