English	This week we will focus on our Christmas Play script Prickly Hay. Children will practise their lines and learn when to come on and off stage. They will also complete a reading/spelling assessment.
Maths	Y1: Numbers to 20. Y2: Multiplication of 2, 5 and 10. Pupils will also complete a maths assessment.
Science	This half term our theme is Seasonal Changes and this week pupils will explore the school grounds to observe the living environment and the changes to plants.
Topic	This term our topic is Our Country and the Local Area. This week pupils will design and build a new home in groups. They will also begin to look at how cityscapes are depicted by artists.
Music	This term pupils will focus on learning the songs for our Christmas play.
RE	Our theme this half term is Incarnation and pupils will consider the question - Why is Christmas important to Christians?
Computing	Children will begin to be able to access and save work to their school account. They will also understand algorithms as programs on a digital device.
PSHE	Our theme this half term is Me and My Safety. This week pupils will identify things which might be dangerous at home, what they might do and how they can make their homes safer.
PE	During the autumn term the children will be doing boxercise on a Tuesday and dance on a Thursday.
