Curriculum over view:

English	We will continue to focus on the book <i>The Journey Home</i> which links to science and topic. This week pupils will be learning rules for plural words and creating a poster.
Maths	Y1: Will focus on space, position and direction. Y2: Will be revising maths learning to date.
Science	This half term our theme is <i>Wild and Wonderful Creatures</i> . This week pupils will be planning a wild animal habitat.
Topic	This term our topic is <i>Sensational Safari</i> . This week pupils will draw a simple map and understand geographical similarities and differences (human and physical geography).
Music	The children will explore traditional African folk songs and use instruments to re-create and explore different rhythms.
RE	Our theme this half term is <i>What do Christians believe God is like?</i> We will focus on the parable <i>The Lost Son</i> and pupils will consider what the story means to Christians.
PSHE	Our theme this half term is <i>Me and Other People</i> . Children will learn to understand and respect the differences between boys and girls, the range of families and racial diversity in British society today.
