Curriculum over view:

English	This week we will focus on recounts which will be presented as a newspaper report. This is linked to the Great Fire of London.
Maths	Y1: Will focus on number bonds using the part whole model so they understand a number is made up of other numbers. Y2: Will focus on addition methods which will include the part whole model, number lines and column method.
Science	This half term we will focus on the theme Animals including Humans. Last week the children were sense detectives and this week they will record what information they found out using their senses.
Topic	This term our topic is The Great Fire of London and this week the children will look at 17th Century building materials and structures. They will explore structures and how to make them stronger.
Music	The children will learn that songs can be based on an historical event.
RE	Our theme this half term is Creation and we will explore the question - who created the world?
PSHE	Our theme this half term is Me and My School. This week we will learn about how a school council meeting works.
Computing	The children will understand what algorithms are and how they are implemented as programs on digital devices.
PE	During the autumn term the children will be doing multi-skills on a Tuesday and dance on a Thursday with our sports coaches.
