Curriculum over view:

English	For the next two weeks we will focus on fantasy stories and use the texts <i>Beegu</i> and <i>Croc and Bird</i> by Alexis Deacon.
Maths	Y1: Will focus on addition within 10. Y2: Will focus on addition and subtraction methods which will include the part whole model, number lines and column method.
Science	This half term we will focus on the theme seasonal weather. This week we will discuss what we know about the weather.
Topic	This term our topic is <i>The Great Fire of London</i> and this week the children will begin some sectional drawing and learn about abstract art.
Music	This half term we will focus on learning the songs for our Christmas play <i>A King is Born</i> .
RE	We will continue our theme <i>Creation</i> and will explore the question - who created the world?
PSHE	Our theme this half term is <i>Me and My Safety</i> . This week we will explore <i>Bonfire Safety</i> and unsafe situations.
Computing	We will focus on <i>Internet Safety</i> .
