**Curriculum over view:**

<b>English</b>	The children will continue to focus on performance poetry this week which has a family theme.
<b>Maths</b>	We will be focusing on number bonds and addition and subtraction.
<b>Science</b>	This half term our theme is People and their Pets (Animals Inc Humans). This week pupils will focus on the question - where do woodlice like living?
<b>Topic</b>	This term our topic is Our Country and the Local Area. This week pupils be using aerial photos to identify landmarks and basic human and physical features.
<b>Music</b>	This week pupils will be participating in an in-school rock band music session with Rock Steady.
<b>RE</b>	Our theme this half term is Families. This week pupils will learn about faith, diversity and what it means to live out beliefs today during the RE event.
<b>Computing</b>	Pupils will continue to use a simple graphics program.
<b>PSHE</b>	Our theme this half term is Me and My School. This week the children will discuss ways to deal with different feelings, particularly negative ones.
<b>PE</b>	During the autumn term the children will be doing multi-skills on a Tuesday and dance on a Thursday.
