**Curriculum over view:**

<b>English</b>	For the next few weeks we will focus on the alternative traditional tale Jim and the Beanstalk.
<b>Maths</b>	Y1: Will complete numbers to 40 and start a unit on shape. Y2: Will focus on money.
<b>Science</b>	This half term our theme is Plants - Growing things. This week pupils will plant a bean in a bag and keep a diary of their observations.
<b>Topic</b>	This term our topic is people who have been famous for more than 5 minutes. This half term we will focus on famous artists. This week the children will use pastels to create their own representation of Van Gogh's sunflowers picture.
<b>Music</b>	The children will prepare for Easter.
<b>RE</b>	Our theme this half term is Belonging to a Group. This week we will explore how baptism is used by the Christian faith to welcomes new members.
<b>PSHE</b>	Our theme this half term is Me and My Relationships.
<b>Computing</b>	The children will learn what a flowchart is and understand how it can be followed. To debug their own and others' flowcharts.
