Curriculum over view:

English	Pupils will finish their pet information fact files. They will write about their visit to St. John's Church on Tuesday.
Maths	Y1: Addition/subtraction within 10. Y2: Addition and subtraction.
Science	This half term our theme is People and their Pets (Animals Inc Humans). This week pupils will sort animals into the five categories, write a riddle about a pet, complete a class pet survey and draw and label the key features found on two pets.
Topic	This term our topic is Our Country and the Local Area. This week pupils will use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key human and physical features in the context of the capital city London. They will also make a model of a London landmark.

RE	Our theme this half term is Families. We will be visiting St. John's Church on Tuesday. Mr Hodgkinson, the Church warden, will talk to pupils about the ways in which the Church is like a family and Christian values.
