### Home Learning

**English/ Topic/ Spelling:** Enjoy reading a book of your choice.

#### Maths

Practise telling the time at different points of the day during the holidays.

Most Y3 should at this stage be able to tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and should be able to draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.

Most Y4 should be able to give the time to the nearest minute using analog and 12-hour digital time (we will be moving on to 24-hour clock by the end of the year).

As you are aware, The National Curriculum expectation for most children at the end of Y3 is that they should know the 2x, 5x, 10x, 4x, 8x and 11x tables. **Y4 should know these and also the 6x, 7x, 9x and 12x tables for their end of year assessments in June.**
