Times Tables

By the end of Y2, most children will know 2x,5x,10x tables.

By the end of Y3, children need to know the, 3x,4x and 8x tables. Y4 need to know all of the others up to 12x 12.

As mentioned in the times tables letters and on our class web page, their learning can be supported by using <https://www.timestables.co.uk/> to practise the times tables that they do not yet already know, using a systematic approach to go through the activities on the website, for example with the 6x tables, Y4 would do this 5- step section of the site: <https://www.timestables.co.uk/6-times-table.html>.

When the children are familiar with all of the multiplication and division facts for all of the times tables, they need to go onto the timed multiplication tables check practice section of the site which is shown on the right-hand menu bar of the home page. This gives a very close simulation of the test taken at the end of Y4 and analyses the answers so that the children are able to focus on learning the ones that they get wrong in a very tailored fashion. This should ensure their progress through the times tables, whilst keeping previous knowledge fresh. Multiplication problem solving (when children know all of their times tables) can be done using <https://nrich.maths.org/13788>

The children are also enjoying using One Minute Maths and still have access to TT Rockstars if they wish to use it for practising recall facts.

Spellings and times tables tests will take place on Thursday this week.
