What are we doing in Class One this week?
Week 4 - 26.09.2022

*This week we are looking forward to continuing our learning all about Harvest and the Little Red Hen. We will be making our own bread rolls this week!

*As stated on the whole school newsletter, we will be hosting our Harvest Festival at St. John's Church on Friday 7th October, 2pm. Pupils will walk to and from the church with their class and teachers. Parents and grandparents are invited to this event and should meet us at the church ready for a prompt 2pm start. Personal, Social & Emotional Development	Our topic this half term is 'Me and My School.' This week we will be completing a checklist of different areas around the school, e.g., office, toilets, photocopier, etc.
