**Curriculum over view:**

<b>English</b>	The children will be planning & writing a story based on the book <i>The Tiger Who Came to Tea</i> . Our author of the week is Judith Kerr so please visit the library to read more of her books or help your child research facts about this author.
<b>Maths</b>	Y1: Place value within 10 Y2: Place Value
<b>Science</b>	This half term our theme will be People and their Pets (Animals Inc Humans). This week pupils will focus on recognising the needs of a human baby for survival.
<b>Topic</b>	This term our topic is Our Country and the Local Area. This week pupils will understand that the United Kingdom is a union of four countries.
<b>Art</b>	Exploring mark making and line.
<b>Music</b>	Listen and appraise - finding the pulse using our body and learning the song <i>Hands, Feet, Heart</i> .
<b>RE</b>	Our theme this half term is What do Christians believe God is like?
<b>Computing</b>	This week pupils will be looking at the 'my work area' on Purple Mash.
<b>RSE</b>	Our theme this half term is <i>Me and My School</i> .
<b>PE</b>	The children will be doing dance on a Tuesday and multi-skills on a Thursday.
